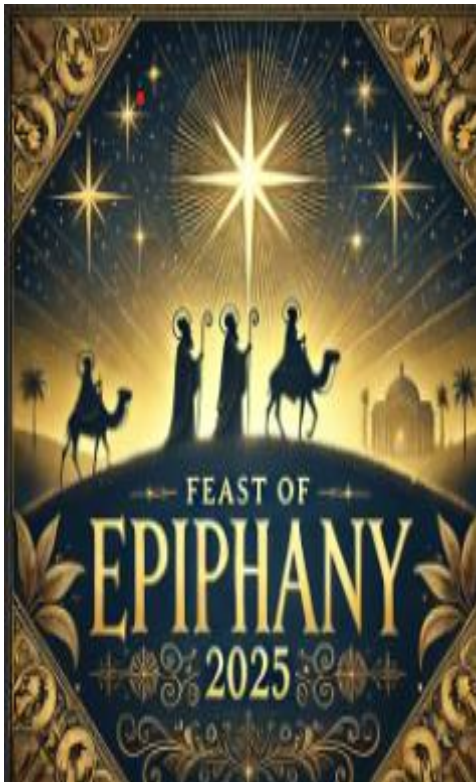

6th January – The Feast of the Epiphany
